Minimum qualifications: Associate faculty will teach professional/technical courses and must have or be able to qualify for post-secondary vocational certification. This includes:

- Significant and recent industry experience related to the teaching field (for all fields)
- Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution (for programming)
- Coursework in MIS/CIS, computer software engineering, computer science or related academic area. Added value is brought to these positions by candidates who carry relevant industry certification. (for other fields)
- Current first aid/CPR certification, and industry certification such as A+, MCP, MCSE, CCNA, or other similar and equivalent industry certification (for networking)

Preferred qualifications: Teaching experience in higher education using learning-outcomes based instruction.
