

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
NORTHSHORE SCHOOL DISTRICT
and
CASCADIA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into as of June 20th, 2012 by and between Cascadia Community College and the Northshore School District.

RECOGNIZING the mutual interest in address the needs of high school juniors and seniors who would benefit from college level courses and who choose to stay on the high school campus to participate in higher education classes, Cascadia Community College and the Northshore School District entered into an Interlocal Agreement on June 14, 2011 for a College in the High School program, and

RECOGNIZING that the superintendent or designee of Northshore School District is authorized to execute and implement that agreement,

THE PARTIES HEREBY agree to this understanding and clarification of the interlocal agreement:

1. All college in the high school courses taught as part of this agreement will be courses approved by the Cascadia Student Learning Council and/or Chief Academic Officer.
2. For the first year of classes offered, enrollment minimums and class percentages specified in the interlocal agreement shall be considered targets and college in the high school classes may run with ten registered students.
3. Entry level qualifications for high school faculty teaching college courses in the high school shall be determined and reviewed by the appropriate discipline faculty at Cascadia. Qualifications must meet the requirements of WAC 131-16-091, and preferred qualifications shall be a Master's degree or at least forty-five graduate level quarter credits in the discipline.
4. All other provisions of the interlocal agreement remain unchanged.

DURATION

This MOU may be modified by mutual written consent. The Agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five years and shall be reviewed annually.
