



SPACE AVAILABLE Tuition Waiver for WA Senior Citizens

This form must be completed in PEN and submitted to Enrollment Services in-person with photo ID and your completed Credit Registration Form.

A new waiver must be completed each quarter for eligibility using the Space Available Tuition Waiver for WA Senior Citizens.

Cascadia waives tuition and S&A fees for credit classes for Washington state residents who are 60 years or older on a space available basis. Classes that have reached maximum capacity are not eligible for the Space Available Tuition Waivers. Each student is responsible for fulfilling the noted prerequisite of each course as listed in the course description (whether the class will be taken as **AUDIT or CREDIT**.) The Space Available Tuition Waiver must be applied as either **AUDIT or CREDIT**. See the explanations for **AUDIT or CREDIT** below and check mark which you would like to apply towards the waiver.

STUDENT INFORMATION

Senior Citizen AUDIT:
Registration in a class for which enrollment is official; however, no grade or credit will be granted. Students will pay \$5 per quarter with a limit of two courses per quarter.
NOTE: Audited classes do not meet prerequisites for higher level course as NO GRADE is earned.

Senior Citizen CREDIT:
Registration in a class for which enrollment is official; a grade and credit will be earned at the end of each quarter. Students will pay \$10 per credit with a limit of two courses per quarter.

	1	Complete this form and a Credit Registration Form.
	2	If prerequisites were taken at another college/university, please see Academic Advisor for override signature on your Credit Registration Form for eligible prerequisites. Students are responsible with providing proof of prerequisites via transcripts or test scores. Math grades or placement must have occurred within the last 24 months to be valid. If the Math placement or grade has been more than 24 months, students must reassess by placement.
	3	Attend the class and let the instructor know that you plan to register using the Senior Citizen tuition waiver. If there is a space available, obtain the instructor's permission by signature on your Credit Registration Form or attach a clearly stated email from the instructor that notes your name, item number, course abbreviation and course number and permission to enroll.
	4	If you are a new student at Cascadia, you must complete the admissions application and pay the application fee before enrolling in classes.
	5	Submit the completed Credit Registration Form, this completed form, and photo ID to Enrollment Services beginning the first day of the quarter to get officially enrolled in the class.
	6	Pay tuition and fees at the time of registration.
