BP03:03.10 Student Financial Services

Cascadia's Student Financial Services Office offers a comprehensive financial program to students using college, state, and federal financial aid resources as well as appropriate private resources. Students who meet eligibility requirements may receive financial assistance in the form of grants, low interest loans, and/or student employment. The Student Financial Services Office provides financial aid information, assists students in obtaining information, determines student eligibility, and manages the college's financial aid programs. In addition, the office assists students with private student loans and scholarships.
