**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**BETWEEN**

**ANTIOCH UNIVERSITY SEATTLE**

**AND**

**CASCADIA COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into as of 7/1, 2012 by and between Cascadia Community College and Antioch University Seattle.

RECOGNIZING the mutual interest in the fields of education, and dissemination of knowledge and also

RECOGNIZING the importance of the role of institutions of higher education in promoting collaboration and increased contribution to student development,

THE PARTIES HEREBY agree to establish collaboration according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder.

**ARTICLE I: SCOPE OF THE COLLABORATION**

The general purpose of this MOU is to facilitate academic cooperation between the parties hereunder based upon the principles of mutual benefit and may include the following general cooperation areas.

**GENERAL AREAS OF COOPERATION**

1.1 Joint educational and research activities.

1.2 Exchange of faculty.

1.3 Discussion for the exchange students for classes or collaborative or independent projects based on the policies of both institutions

1.4 Exchange scholarly information on best practices.

1.5 Invitations for attending scholarly meetings and professional development activities where possible and appropriate.

1.6 Neither institution is responsible for any financial support under this MOU. Individual scholars will make all arrangements by written agreement, which will be applicable to each particular situation.

**ARTICLE IV: DURATION**

This MOU may be modified by mutual written consent. The Agreement will be in effect from the date of signature for a period of five years and shall be reviewed annually. It shall be renewed upon mutual written agreement. This agreement may be terminated by either side with six months' written notice.



This agreement is only for this course and does not represent an agreement to any other enrollment arrangements.


