

Aroha Compassion Emergency Grant

Dropping classes because of a financial pinch?

Cascadia wants to help keep you in the classroom. If you can't pay for basic needs due to an emergency or unexpected circumstance, you can apply for an Aroha Compassion Grant. These are small grants designed to cover a variety of one-time expenses. Documentation of the need is required.

1. Meet with a CARE Team member to discuss your circumstances and determine the best resources.
2. Complete the Aroha Compassion Grant application if a CARE Team member recommends doing so.
3. Program Staff will notify you of the results of your application within two business days. Timeframes may vary depending on the time of the year and volume of requests received.
4. Awards are disbursed within two business days after an award decision is made. You will receive confirmation and instructions for disbursement.
