Tomorrow is Veterans Day, we would like to thank you for your service to this country and we do not forget the sacrifice made by you and those who are not with us here today. In observance of Veterans Day there will be no classes held on November 11<sup>th</sup> and all campus offices will be closed.

### Winter 2021 Registration

Registration for the Winter Quarter opened last week. Please register ASAP to ensure that you get into the classes that you need. Please remember that the VA only covers classes needed for your Cascadia degree.

### Veterans Quarterly Form

The **Veterans Quarterly Form** for Winter 2021 is moving online! Please complete a Veterans Quarterly Form immediately after you register for Winter classes or anytime that you change your schedule. The Quarterly Form informs the Veteran Services office that you plan to use your VA funding for the Winter Quarter.

Please submit your Veterans Quarterly Form by 17:00 on December 2, 2020 to prevent delay in processing your certification and avoid any delay to receiving benefits that you are eligible for including BAH, transportation or textbook allowances. There is no need to resubmit the online form if you already emailed a copy of the pdf form.
