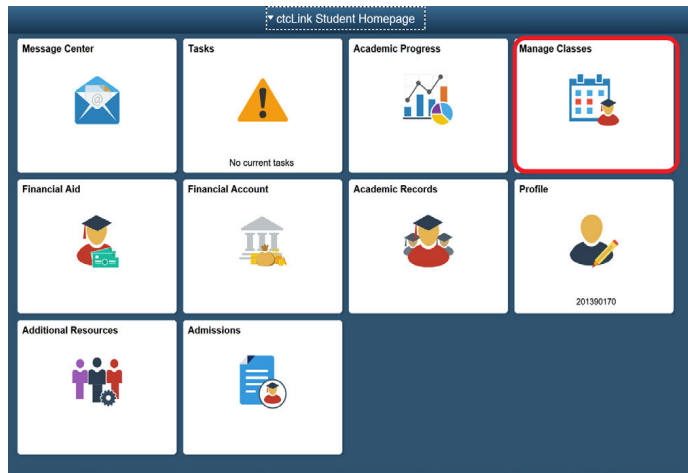
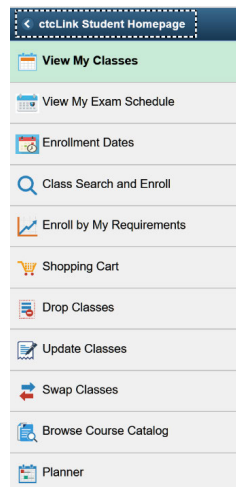


From the ctcLink Student Homepage click on the **Manage Classes** tile.

This will also open a search where you have many different ways to narrow down the classes you want to look at.

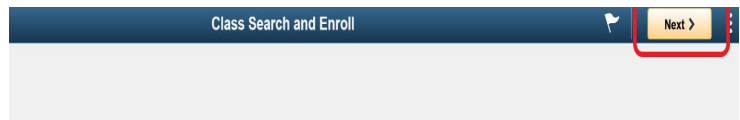
