...you're NOT in a class that offers Supplemental Instruction (SI). If SI is an option for you and your classmates, you should take advantage of it!

A tutor can help you out by...

...keeping the group on track.

...identifying challenging ideas or problems that your group should focus on.

...suggesting specific study strategies.

Please don't expect your tutor to...

...come up with a plan or agenda for the study session.

...teach or reteach the material. The tutor's job is different from the instructor's job.
